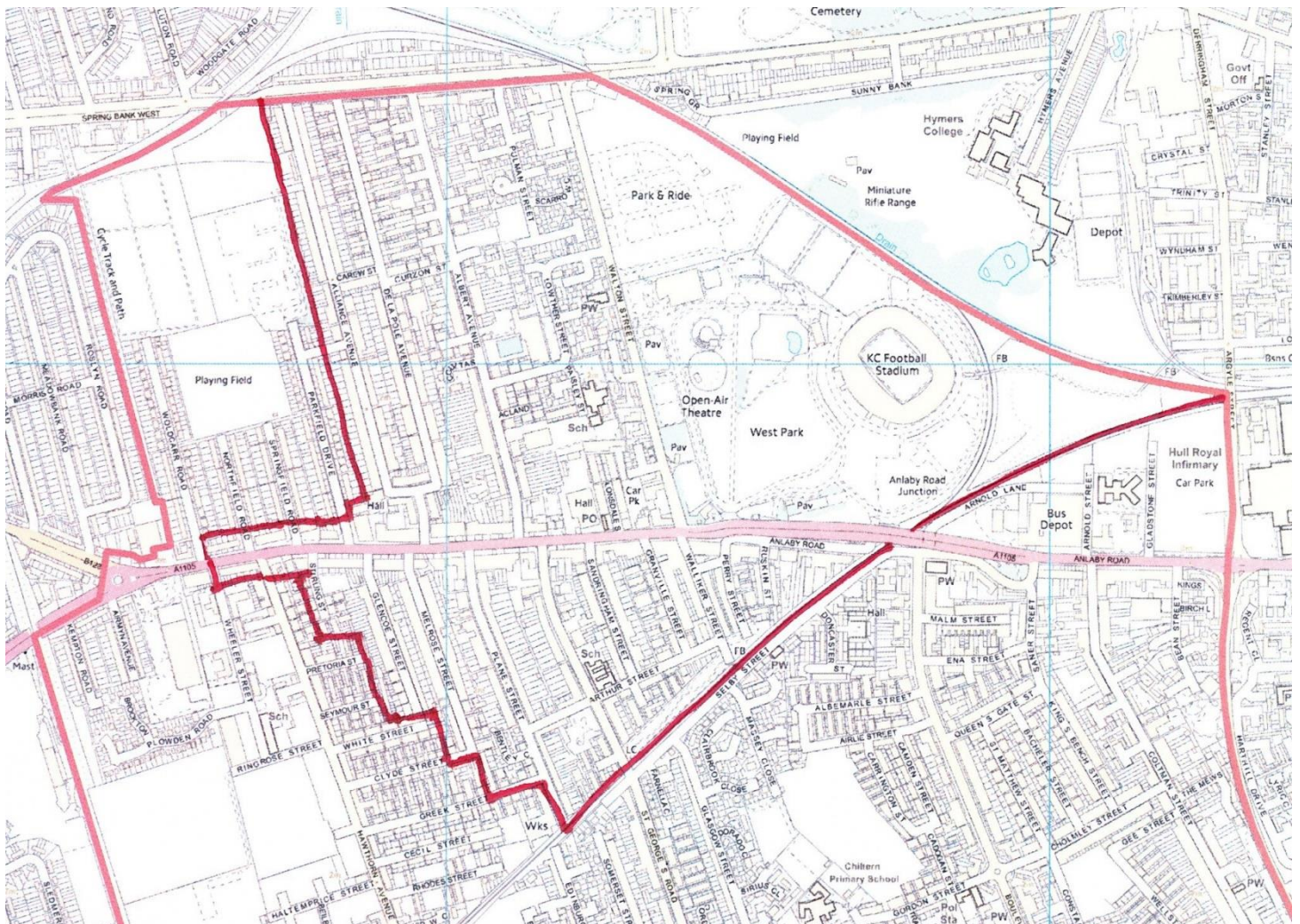


Newington Neighbourhood Plan Questionnaire 2016



The Newington Neighbourhood Plan is about bringing the local community together to produce a vision for the area and planning policies for the next 15 years. The designated area for the plan is illustrated in the map above. The next stage of the plan is a community wide consultation process to find out how the people that live and work in the area wish it to be developed. The plan will involve the whole community and provide a means of inspiring people to come together to make a real positive difference to our community.

As well as empowering the local community we envisage that the plan will produce real tangible benefits such as improving the urban design of the area, making green spaces more suitable for community use, reviving trade, stimulating local organisations to work in partnership and in creating new community enterprises. The plan may determine planning applications and grant planning permission through Neighbourhood Development Orders and Community Right to Build Orders for specific developments. Though the plan does not directly draw down any funding it will provide a basis for procuring and determining resource priorities for the area and in establishing clear evidence of need for major funding initiatives.

Green Spaces

- What is your view about local green spaces including local gardens and parks, West Park and the neglected land to the rear of the KC Stadium (*The 'Railway Triangle'*)?
- Is there scope for improvements and if so what improvements would you like to see?
- Are there any events, facilities or activities taking place in green spaces you would like to see?

KC Stadium

- Do you have any views on the sporting facilities and land managed by the Stadium Management Company?
- Do you have any ideas on how KC facilities could better benefit local residents?
- Are there any additional sports facilities you would like to see developed for the local community?

Urban Design

Urban Design involves the design of buildings, spaces and landscapes for example shop fronts, green spaces, street furniture, access routes etc.

- In what ways do you think the design of the local environment could be improved?
- What is your view on the street scene on Anlaby Road including use of roller shutters, street furniture, litter bins etc.?
- Are there any problem spaces or environments you are aware of that accumulate litter, or attract anti-social behaviour?

Traffic & Pedestrians

(For example parking permits, public car parks, bus lanes, traffic congestion, cycle routes, pedestrian access, zebra crossings etc.)

- Do you have any concerns about highway and transport issues in the area?
- Do you have any ideas about how public access routes and facilities could be improved?

Anything Else?

- Are there any other matters of concern or opportunities for development in the area you want to tell us about?
